- SILC: Shore Infrastructure and Logistics Center Management for Civil Engineering Field Units executing shore infrastructure and base operations programs.
- FD&CC: Facility Design and Construction Center Primary executor of capital construction programs.
- **CEU:** Civil Engineering Units


 Primary executor of facility maintenance and repair programs.

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS



National Multiple Award Construction Contracts (NMACC)

- •FDCC Executes; DHS-wide Design-Build construction contracts
- •Task Order Limits \$3M \$100M / \$500M Total Order Limit
- Task Orders: Price Only or Best Value
- •Base Year + 6 one-year Options 8 contracts awarded May 2010

Regional Multiple Award Construction Contracts (RMACCs)

- CEU's execute regional Maintenance & Repair construction contracts
- Projects range from \$5K to \$3M in value
- Mix of Hubzone, 8A, & SDVOSB contracts by USCG District (regional)
- Terms vary, awarded during 2009-2010



CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS



- Tower Multiple Award Construction Contracts
 - (5) CG Wide Design-Build Construction
 - Awarded Mar 2012, 5yr contracts, \$1M/yr



A/E SERVICES CONTRACTS



- Environmental IDIQ Contracts (6) CG Wide
 - Awarded Mar 2008, 5yr contracts, \$2.5M/yr
 - Expires 2013; Follow-on Procurement in process
- Marine Inspection IDIQ Contracts (7) CG Wide
 - Awarded Oct 2009, 5yr contracts, \$2M/yr
- Gen. A/E Services IDIQ Contracts (6) DHS Wide
 - Awarded Mar 2007, 10 yr contracts, \$5M/yr






