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The Pacific island national parks are part of the Pacific West Region which also includes CA, NV, OR, WA, and ID

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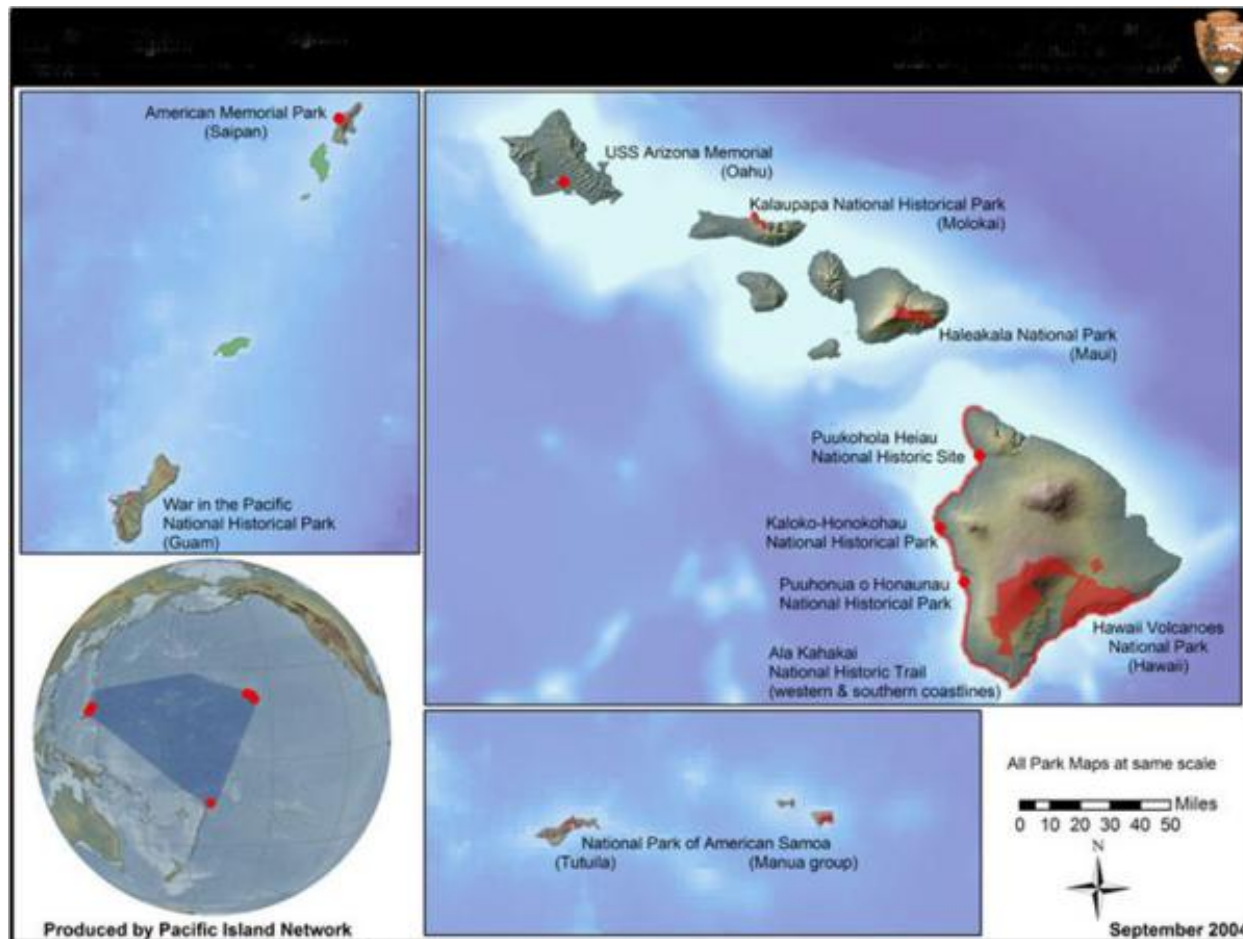


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There are 11 national parks in the pacific islands

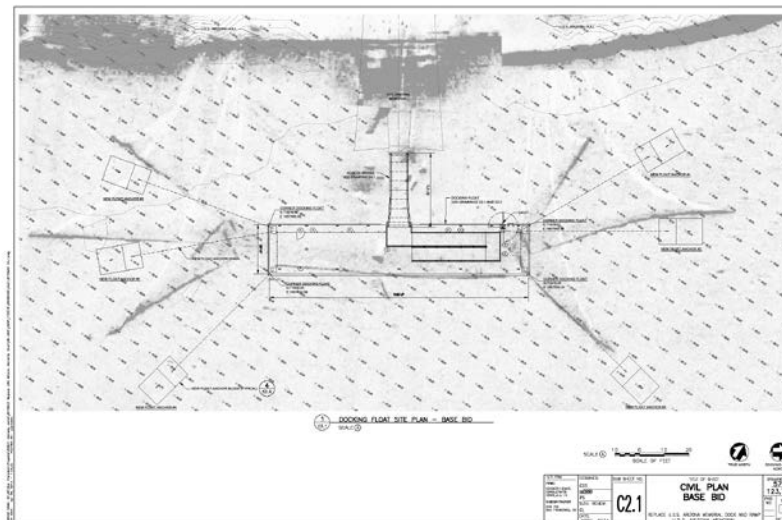
